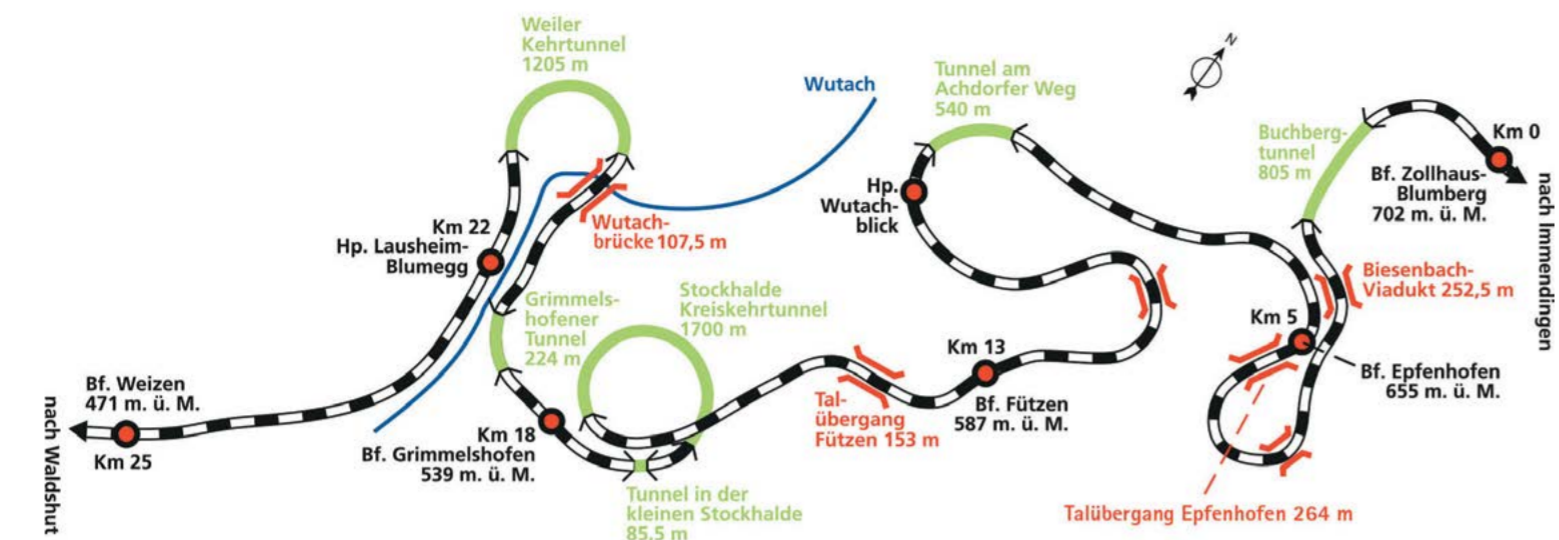

The unique route through the Wutach Valley



Criss-cross the landscape on the „Sauschwänzlebahn“

The town of Blumberg started running trains on the railway line built as a “strategic route” between Blumberg-Zollhaus and Weizen in 1977 as a museum railway for steam trains in cooperation with EUROVAPOR. The museum railway line is 25 km long. It was built between 1887 and 1890 by the former “Großherzoglich Badischen Staatseisenbahn” (which translates to “Grand Ducal Bavarian State Railway”) and de-commissioned by the German Federal Railway on 1 May 1976. Today, it serves as a cultural monument of national importance to the railway technology of its age, a testament to the exceptional engineering of the 19th century. Its curving course has given rise to the train’s popular nickname, Sauschwänzlebahn, which roughly translates to “wiggly train”. We invite all historical train fans to enjoy an unforgettable journey. Pottering along at the speed of an old-fashioned choo choo train, you’ll experience the enchanting Kommen Valley, the wild, romantic Wutach Valley, the geologically fascinating Mühlbach Valley, magnificent viaducts, idyllic villages and whitewater rivers, bridges and numerous river loops plus Germany’s unique circular tunnel.

All of that in one stretch of charming landscape nestled between Buchberg and Randen near the Swiss border. This exciting journey wends its way from the railway station at Blumberg-Zollhaus (702 m above sea level) through the 805 m long Buchberg Tunnel. The train then passes along the Biesenbach Viaduct (252.5 m long, 24 m tall), the Epfenhofen Valley Pass (264 m long, 34 m tall), the Tunnel am Achdorfer Weg (540 m), the Wutachblick (Wutach View) stop, Fützen railway station, the Fützen Valley Pass (153 m long, 28 m tall), the Stockhalde Circular Tunnel (700 m in diameter, 1700 m long, spiral incline of 15.5 m), the small Stockhalde Tunnel (85.5 m), Grimmelshofen railway station, the Grimmelshofen Tunnel (224 m), the Wutach Bridge (107.5 m long, 28 m tall), the helical tunnel in Weiler (1205 m), the Lausheim-Blumegg stop and Weizen railway station. Height difference, Weizen-Buchbergsattel: 231 m to 9.6 km as the crow flies, route length 25 km.
